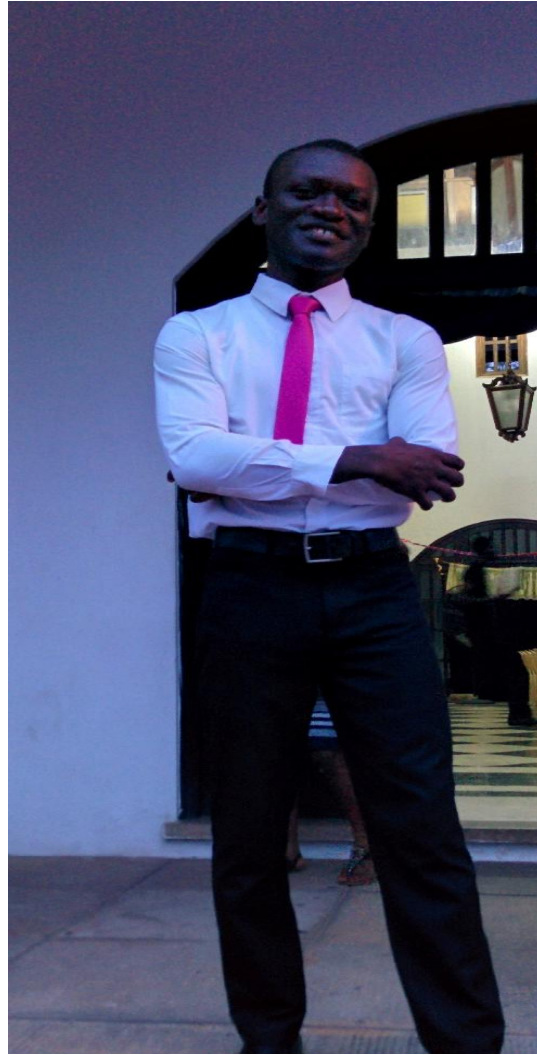


Prince Ofori
