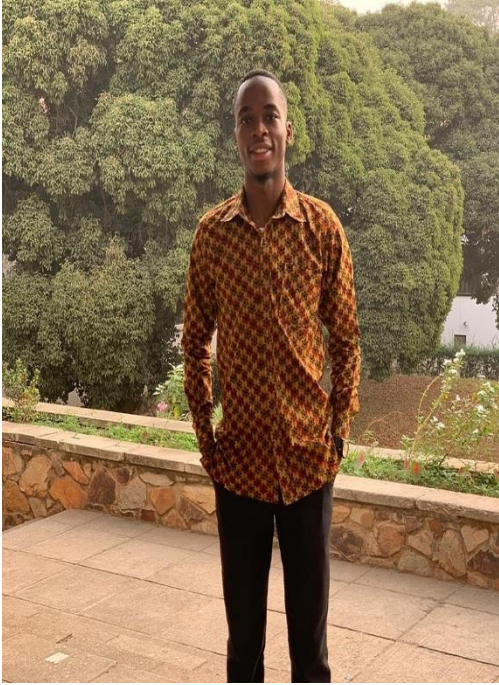


SAMUEL GAMELI TSORLEVO
