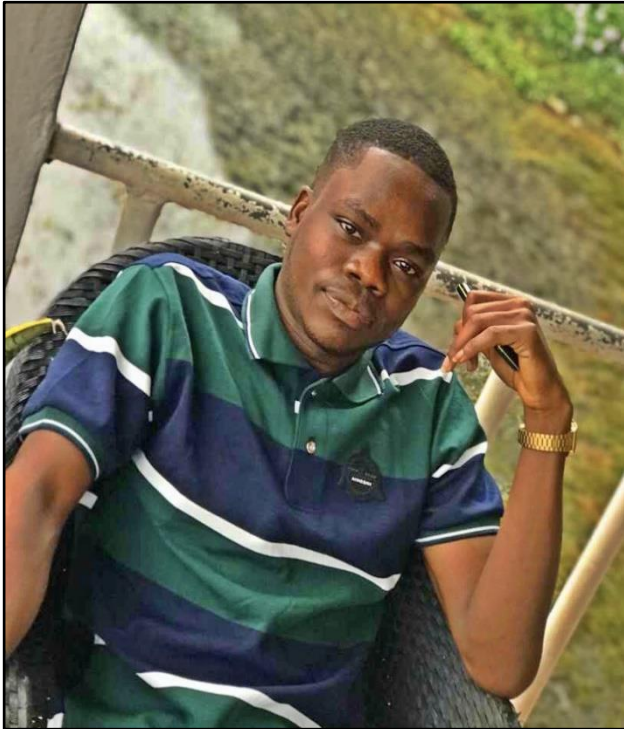


GIDEON ANAGLI
